Hajra Waheed's multidisciplinary practice ranges from interactive installations to collage, video, sound and sculpture. Amongst other issues, she explores the nexus between security, surveillance and the covert networks of power that structure lives while also addressing the traumas and alienation of displaced subjects affected by legacies of colonial and state violence. Waheed has participated in exhibitions worldwide, most recently including the *57th International Art Exhibition – La Biennale di Venezia, VIVA ARTE VIVA*, Venice (2017); *11th Gwangju Biennale*, South Korea (2016); *The Cyphers*, BALTIC Centre for Contemporary Art, Gateshead, UK (2016); *Still Against the Sky*, KW Institute for Contemporary Art, Berlin (2015); *L'avenir (Looking Forward)*, La Biennale de Montréal, Musée d'art contemporain de Montréal, QC (2014). She was shortlisted for the 2016 Sobey Art Award and received the 2014 Victor Martyn Lynch-Staunton Award for outstanding achievement as a Canadian mid-career visual artist. Waheed's works can be found in permanent collections including MOMA, New York; British Museum, London; the National Gallery of Canada, Ottawa; Burger Collection, Zurich/Hong Kong, Devi Art Foundation, New Delhi and The Art Institute of Chicago, Chicago.
